

BluePay: Installation Guide

Version 1.0.5 – For Magento® 1 – Updated 2017-02-21

Installation

The installation process differs based on where you purchased our extension.

If you purchased from Magento Marketplace

Step 1: Download the Software


Download the extension from the Magento Marketplace. If you need help, follow the official guide here to download: http://docs.magento.com/marketplace/user_guide/quick-tour/downloads.html

We strongly recommend installing, configuring, and testing all extensions on a development website before installing and using them in production.

Step 2: Open Magento Connect Manager

After purchasing the extension from the Magento Marketplace, login to the admin panel and head to **System > Magento Connect > Magento Connect Manager**. You will be prompted to login, using the same admin level credentials to login to Magento Connect Manager.

If you are installing the extension on a live website, check the setting to **Put store on the maintenance mode**.




Step 3: Upload

After purchasing the extension, you should have received an archive file. Select **Choose File** and locate the archive file you stored on your device. Once you have set the **Settings** and **Direct package file upload** settings as specified above, click the **Upload** button.



Step 4: Install

After clicking **Upload** the terminal window at the bottom of the screen will output any errors and success messages. If the installation fails at any point, you will be given an error message and will need to fix the error(s) to attempt the install again.

Step 5: Configure

Once the installation is complete, return to the admin panel and continue with the configuration section below.

If you purchased from store.paradoxlabs.com

Step 1: Upload files

Upload all files within the **upload** folder into the root directory of Magento.

Folder in Download	Folder on Server
/upload/app/	→ /app/

Step 2: Refresh the Cache

To complete the installation process, open the Admin Panel and go to **System > Cache Management**. Click the **Flush Magento Cache** button at the top-right and wait for the page to load.

Step 3: Configure


Configuration

Enter API Information

Before proceeding: Sign up for a [BluePay merchant account](#) if you have not already done so.

Open your Admin Panel and go to **System > Configuration > Payment Methods**. If the extension was uploaded correctly, you will see a new section on this page titled **BluePay**. Enter your BluePay **Account ID** and **Secret Key**, and complete the rest of the configuration as desired.

To find your BluePay account details, log in to the BluePay Virtual Terminal, then go to **Administration > Accounts > List**. Click the 'View' icon next to your account. You should see the following page. Your account ID and secret key are highlighted in red.



Once you've completed all of the payment module settings, click **Save Config** to save your changes.

Set up Cron

To use the recurring billing features of this extension, you must set up Magento's Cron scheduler in your server's crontab or scheduler if you have not already done so. This will need to be done either through your server control panel or through SSH. Magento's scheduling script, cron.php, should be executed at intervals of 15 minutes or less.

Enable Logging

If logs are enabled in Magento, this extension will record any errors if something goes wrong.

To set up logging, in FTP, go into the **var** folder in your Magento installation, and create a folder called **log** if it does not already exist. Be sure to set the folder permissions such that Magento can write to it. Once that is done, in the Admin Panel go to **System > Configuration > Developer > Log Settings**, enable logs, and save.
